5. Proposal for new BSUP projects received from

Iharkhand

- 5.1 The representative of the State of Jharkhand made a presentation seeking approval to 2 BSUP projects at Dhanbad (Ph. V) and Adityapur Jamshedpur.
- 5.2 The Committee observed the following:
 - i. The beneficiary contribution is on higher side. State needs to take the willingness of the beneficiaries after due consultative process.
 - State/ULB has to formulate an appropriate structure for ensuring proper maintenance of common area and assets after completion.
 - iii. The DPRs provide bio-digesters for sewerage disposal.
 - iv. SLNA has to furnish duly authenticated DPR containing administrative & technical check-list counter signed by SLNA, certificates/undertakings required, building design drawings, layout plans and cost estimate duly signed by the competent

BSUP project for Construction of 4550 DUs and provision of Infrastructure facility at GHMC area Hyderabad.

9.6 Since the Committee deferred the proposals seeking ex-post-facto approval for the modified DPR of this Project, it also deferred the proposals seeking 4th installment of ACA for this project and advised the State to resubmit proposal along with compliance to the observations of the Committee at Para 6.5 and after releasing proportionate State share as per the revised project cost.

(Action: State to take action on the observations of the Committee).

10 Payment of charges for analysis of TPIMA reports

10.1 The Director (JNNURM) made a presentation on the proposal for payment of charges for analysis of TPIMA reports by the monitoring agencies i.e. HUDCO and BMTPC. He informed that there are 30 agencies empanelled for TPIM work for BSUP and IHSDP projects. The TPIMA reports along with SLNA's comments received in the JNNURM Directorate are being analysed by the appraisal and monitoring agencies: HUDCO and BMTPC for consideration by the CSMC while approving 3rd and 4th installments of ACA for BSUP and 2nd installment of ACA for IHSDP projects. He stated that the appraisal agencies have claimed Rs. 12,000/- per report for analysis work.

10.2 The Committee observed that the proposal is in accordance with the JNNURM guidelines. It held detailed deliberations on the proposal and considered the workload involved in the examination of TPIMA reports running into volumes and the need to assist the CSMC in dealing with release of installments under BSUP and IHSDP based on presentation of TPIMA findings, SLNA's action thereon and checking as to whether the TPIMA concerns have been addressed adequately. The Committee however approved a moderate sum of Rs. 8000/- per TPIMA report for analytical work and directed the Mission Directorate to obtain approval of the Internal Finance Division and the Competent Authority for meeting the expenditure from out of 1% JNNURM funds available with the Mission Directorate.

(Action: JNNURM Directorate to seek approval from the IFD & the Competent Authority and communicate the decision to the Appraisal & Monitoring agencies HUDCO & BMTPC).

SPECIAL AGENDA FOR THE CSMC MEETING PAYMENT FOR ANALYSIS OF TPIM REPORT

To ensure quality implementation of projects under JNNURM (BSUP and IHSDP) 30 agencies have been empanelled as State Level TPIM Agencies. 2 agencies at the Central level have been named as Central TPIM Agencies. These agencies will be visiting more than 1400 projects with multiple site visits and give the Ministry and State Governments the feedback regarding quality of implementation of projects apart from looking into the processes followed for sanction, execution and quality assurance of works. Already more than 500 reports have been received and the same are being examined by HUDCO and BMTPC. These organizations have already put up a large number of manpower to examine the TPIM Reports which run into 100s of pages. Examining the TPIM reports cannot be entrusted to private agencies as these are valuable documents and there is possibility of vested interest if the same are examined by private agencies. Therefore, approval of CSMC is requested for entrusting the reports for examination to HUDCO and BMTPC who have been the appraising agencies. As regards fees for examining the reports is concerned, it is ascertained that the manpower requirement would cost the agencies about Rs. 10,000/- per report. In fact, HUDCO and BMTPC have asked for sanction of Rs. 12,000/- per report on an average basis. After due examination of the cost involved by the Missian Directorate, it is proposed that CSMC may sanction Rs. 8,000/- for examination of the report which may be paid from out of the 1% JNNURM funds available with the Ministry.
